PetFIX Sick Appointments are available for dogs and cats. Our clinic is a limited-service veterinary facility focused on evaluating and treating non-emergency medical conditions.

We provide diagnostic testing and other treatments onsite, though some services may require referral to a full-service veterinary hospital.

What's Included

- Evaluation and management of non-emergency medical conditions, including mild to moderate illness or chronic conditions
- Assessment of digestive, skin, ear, and urinary concerns
- Routine monitoring of ongoing medical conditions
- Preventive health follow-up as recommended
- Onsite diagnostics such as bloodwork, urinalysis, fecal testing, and other treatments (not all services listed—please ask our staff)

Important Instructions

- Pets should be brought in a secure carrier or on a leash
- Arrive on time to allow for paperwork and consultation procedures

Quality of Life & End-of-Life Services

We are here to support pets and their families during end-of-life decisions. Quality of Life (QOL) appointments are **consultations to discuss your pet's comfort, health, and overall well-being**. These appointments **may or may not result in euthanasia**.

Euthanasia Services

- Provided **for medical conditions only**; behavioral euthanasia is not performed

- Proof of ownership is required at check-in

*Cremation services are **not included** and are available at an additional cost. Ashes cannot be returned.

*Any animal over 120 lbs will also incur a \$125 special transport fee in addition to the cremation charge
