What's Included in the Exam

- A full physical examination by a licensed veterinarian
- Review of your pet's vaccination and medical history
- Assessment of weight, body condition, and overall health

- Discussion of preventive care, nutrition, and lifestyle recommendations
- Recommendations for additional testing if indicated (e.g., blood panels, urinalysis)
- **All pets, including new patients, are required to have a wellness exam at least once per year. New pets must have an initial exam before receiving other services to ensure proper preventive care and ongoing health.**

Important Instructions for Your Visit

- Please bring your pet's vaccination records if available.
- Arrive on time to allow for paperwork and exam procedures.
- Pets should be brought in a secure carrier or on a leash.
- If your pet is anxious or prone to stress, consider bringing a favorite blanket or toy for comfort.
